## REQUIREMENTS FOR THESES

Theses are typed in the Microsoft Word 2003 editor, on an A4 sheet (210x297 mm), margins (mm): top – 20, bottom – 20, left – 25, right – 10.

- Font – Times New Roman, pin – 14, paragraph – 1.25 cm, line spacing – 1, style – Normal.
- On the first line, on the left, the number and name of the section is indicated, below - UDC. After 1 interval on the right, information about the author is indicated: surname, first name and patronymic (in full), scientific degree, academic title, name of the educational institution. Next, in the center, the name of the thesis of the report is indicated in bold, after which the text is presented;
- Name of the table: Times New Roman, point 14, bold, without paragraph indent, alignment - in the center.
- Captions to figures: Times New Roman, point 14, bold, without paragraph indentation, alignment - in the center.
- The font in tables and figures is Times New Roman, point 12, regular, single line spacing, indent 1.
- The list of used sources should contain only the sources to which there are references in the text; example of design of links: [1, p. 127].
